CALL FOR PAPERS

The focus of MobiMedia this year will be on:

Quality of Experience in Pervasive Media Networks and Applications

MobiMedia is aimed at addressing subjects related to the successful acquisition, processing, transmission and delivery of multimedia content where the mobility of the users is a key feature. This year the conference will put a special attention to the Quality of Experience in Pervasive Media Networks and Applications, which is the focus theme of this year edition.

Key research areas of the conference include (but are not limited to):

- *Application and channel coding paradigms*, including for example joint source and channel coding paradigms, scalable video coding, wireless and ad hoc network solutions, ciphering and authentication.
- *Networking and transmission mechanisms*, including for example transport and network protocol solutions, cross-layer techniques, rate control and adaptation mechanism for video delivery, impact of mobility and heterogeneous networks in multimedia delivery and p2p content delivery
- *Multimedia services, business models and concepts*, including for example new business models and service concepts, trust and security paradigms for multimedia delivery, test beds and experimentation platforms for multimedia.

Paper submission and publication::

All submissions should be written in English with a maximum paper length of 15 single-column pages including figures. All papers must be formatted using Springer LNICST Authors' Kit [<ftp://ftp.springer.de/pub/tex/latex/lnicst/>] and submitted through the ASSYST paper management system (<http://assyst-online.org>).

Accepted papers will be published by Springer in the [Lecture Notes of the Institute for Computer Sciences, Social Informatics and Telecommunications Engineering](#) (LNICST) series.

Workshops::

Proposals for half-day or one-day workshops to be held in conjunction with the conference are solicited. A maximum of 2 pages should be submitted which include the workshop name, its scope and a list of topic of interests.
